- DO NOT attempt to join luminaires together on the floor. Damage may result when lifted.





Step 1 - Feed & Mounting Locations


Feed Location

- · Position luminaire on wall in desired location.
- Mark the top corner of the luminaire, not including the endcap. This is Point A.
 Use Point A to find and mark feed location.
- Position and install starter wall rail. (See page 3.)



Mounting Locations

- X = Luminaire section length(X Measurements do not include endcaps)
- · Position wall rails as indicated to the right.
- Center of starter wall rail is 6" (± 3/4") from Point A.
- Ensure wall rail mounts are secured to proper structural support.




Step 1 - Feed & Mounting Locations



A. Mount Wall Rail





- Level wall rail to ensure proper mounting.
- Install screws through rail and into proper structure support.1



• Install all wall rails, ensuring they are level with each other.








Step 2 - Identification & Preparation




A. Identify Luminaires





- Identify all luminaires by their ID label that can be found on the box, the diffuser, and inside the luminaire.
- NOTE: Exact location of labels in these areas may vary.
- · Remove all luminaires from their box.
- · Refer to record drawings that can be found in the hardware kit.


B. Remove Diffusers Top-Down View



- Carefully remove all diffusers, keeping them inside their protective bags.
- Set aside all diffusers to prevent them from getting dirty or damaged.
- Ensure diffusers can be clearly identified back to their corresponding luminaire.

Kitted Hardware

- Finelite has provided items listed here, with their Finelite part numbers. These items can be found in separate boxes shipped with the luminaire.
- Account for all parts and set aside until they are needed.
- All other hardware needed for this installation will be by others.







- NOTE: For independent luminaires, backplates do not need to be released.
- Release the backplates from clips by sliding the blade of a putty knife behind backplate edges.
- To use a flathead screwdriver, press end of screwdriver (from inside the luminaire) against the clip, until the backplate is released.







Step 4 - Mounting Starter to Structure









• Install wet rated conduit onto the luminaire.



- While properly supporting luminaire, make electrical connections and push complete connections into luminaire.
- Position starter luminaire in place so that the top and bottom hooks of the wall bracket engage with the top and bottom hooks of the wall rail.



- If there is no joiner/ender, then secure starter luminaire to wall rail with a mounting screw and perform leveling. Tightening the screw raises and loosening the screw lowers the front edge of the luminaire. PROCEED TO STEP 7B.
- If continuing with a joiner luminaire, do not perform leveling yet. PROCEED TO STEP 5.















Step 5 - Joining Luminaires








• Maneuver joiner/ender luminaire to wall and engage top and bottom hooks of the wall bracket with the top and bottom hooks of the wall rail.

• Align joiner/ender with aligner sleeves on starter and slide together. Be careful not to damage any wiring.





Step 6 - Securing Luminaire Joints





- Before installing yoke brackets, ensure the joining ends of luminaires meet flush and square.
- CRITICAL: Ensure yoke brackets properly engage with aligner sleeves.
- Secure joint by threading (but not yet tightening) yoke screws through yoke brackets and washers and into the aligner sleeves.
- Tighten yoke screws1 until joint seam of luminaires is closed.












Step 7 - Closing Luminaires





- **NOTE:** If your installation includes a battery backup, please see addendum (98333) that should be included with your kitting package.
- Reinstall any open backplates by rotating into luminaire body and snapping back into clips.
- Remove diffusers from protective plastic bag.
- CAUTION: Wear gloves to keep diffuser surface clean, take care to wipe off any water or condensation on diffusers before installing into luminaire.
- CRITICAL: Be sure to install correct diffuser to its corresponding luminaire ID.
- Install diffusers into luminaire body, ensuring they snap into place.
- Reinstall all endcap and joint diffuser covers.
- Turn power on to luminaire.



• Secure joiner/ender luminaire to wall rail with a mounting screw.
