## **U.S. Treasurer Rosie Rios Attends Roundtable Event at Finelite**

Local CEOs discuss state of manufacturing industry

### Rios Says US on Road to Recovery

Ms. Rios is a member of President Barack Obama's Business Council and a senior adviser to Treasury Secretary Timothy Geithner. Before heading into the event, she said, "Job creation happens to be at the forefront of this recovery and it also happens to be my passion." The 30-40 manufacturing firms in attendance had a chance to talk to Rios confidentially about what was and was not working with the Obama administration's current manufacturing initiatives and federal policies. Rios has been meeting with similar groups across the nation and recently related that she believed the American economy is on the road to recovery.

#### **Finelite Takes Lead Role**

Terry Clark, Chairman and Chief Technology Officer of Finelite, said he was honored to host the event for Rios. He commented that more jobs means more schools and offices will have better quality and more efficient lighting across the state and nation. Clark revealed the key points to Finelite's growth strategy: "We're vibrant, we're expanding, we're creating jobs."

Presently Finelite has about 175 employees, but plans are in the works to hire 50 more people by summer. Clark said just last year hiring was across the board, from entry-level factory workers to a new CEO, Jerry Mix, whose commitment to innovation and customer service will yield continued job growth for Finelite.

Commenting further about the event, Clark said, "Finelite is an active participant in a number of U.S. DOE efforts to promote Solid State Lighting luminaires.
