

Step 1 - Mounting & Suspension




Mounting Options Top-Down View

Option 1

T-Bar Off-Grid Mounting

J-Box and appropriate 1/4" - 20 Fastener

- Locate power feed on luminaire.
- Install J-Box and electrical conduit at feed location.
- Install appropriate 1/4"-20 fasteners at mounting point locations.
- All appropriate 1/4"-20 fasteners are to be secured to structure, per local building codes.











Option 2 Drywall (C4) or other hard surfaces* **J-Box and Anchor Bolts**

- · Locate power feed on luminaire.
- Install J-Box and electrical conduit at feed location.
- Install anchor bolts at mounting point locations.
- · All anchor bolts are to be secured to structure, per local building codes.


*Other hard surfaces include: wood, sheet metal panels, steel beams, concrete or masonry. Use hardware appropriate for each surface material type.

1/4"-20 Anchor Bolt - Hard Surface




1/4"-20 Fastener - T-Bar Off-Grid (by others)

Identify Luminaire






- Identify all luminaires by their ID label that can be found on the box and inside the luminaire.
- NOTE: Exact location of labels in these areas may vary.
- Remove all luminaires from their box.
- Refer to Record Drawings that can be found in the hardware kit.

Locate ID Label Bottom-Up View



Wear gloves to keep diffuser surface clean.



Push up diffuser to locate ID label inside luminaire.

Kitted Hardware

- Finelite has provided items listed here, with their Finelite part numbers. These items can be found in separate boxes shipped with the luminaire.
- Account for all parts and set aside until they are needed.
- All other hardware needed for this installation will be by others.





Step 3 - Mounting Luminaire to Structure



A. Install Grippers Top-Down View






Install grippers onto 1/4"-20 studs.

- Slide canopy appropriate for electrical type options onto mounting bolt (anchor bolt or appropriate 1/4"-20 fastener).
- Thread the slip ring onto mounting bolts and secure with set screw at both mounting locations.
- Thread the bushing/cable assembly onto mounting bolts.
- While properly supporting luminaire, maneuver luminaire to ceiling and insert cables into grippers to support luminaire from the ceiling.



C. Make Electrical Connections Bottom-Up View

WIRING LEGEND		
Black	Hot	Line Voltage
White	Neutral	Line Voltage
Green	Ground	
Pink	Dimming	0-10V DC
Purple	Dimming	0-10V DC



Feed power cord through the 5" canopy and connect wires inside the J-Box.






Step 4 - Level & Crimp Safety Cable









- **CRITICAL**: Ensure all leveling has been performed by depressing top of grippers to adjust cable lengths prior to applying safety crimp.
- Run aircraft cable through safety crimp and safety tab, make a loop, and then run aircraft cable back through safety crimp.
- NOTE: Either safety tab may be used.
- Crimp and cut excess aircraft cable to lock in place. Typical for each aircraft cable.

- Remove protective film carefully.
- Turn power on to luminaire.
