- DO NOT attempt to join luminaires together on the floor. Damage may result when lifted.





Mounting Options

- Install threaded rods to structure.
- Threaded rod must exceed distance to wall/ceiling surface by 1-1/2".

Option 2 - Mount to T-Bar

- Install caddy clips onto T-Bar at mounting point locations.
- All caddy clips are to be secured to structure, per local building codes.


Option 3 - Mount to Support Structure


- Support blocking must not exceed distance to wall/ceiling surface.
- Install electrical junction box and electrical conduit at feed locations.

Mounting Locations

X = Luminaire section length (**X** Measurements **do not include** endcaps)

HP-2	5"	3/4"

- Luminaire mounting holes sized for 1/4"-20 hardware.
- Refer to Record Drawings and building plans to determine exact mounting, suspension points, and power feed locations.
- CRITICAL: Drywall or weak paneling must be secured to support blocking (studs) around wall/ceiling.



Step 2 - Identification & Preparation





A. Identify Luminaires






- Identify all luminaires by their ID label that can be found on the box, on the diffuser, and inside the luminaire.
- NOTE: Exact location of labels in these areas may vary.
- · Remove all luminaires from their box.
- Refer to Record Drawings that can be found in the hardware kit.







- 1. Slide putty knife between the backplate and diffuser.
- 2. Carefully separate diffuser from the backplate, keeping it inside its protective bag.
- · Carefully remove all diffusers.
- · Set aside all diffusers to prevent from getting dirty or damaged.
- Ensure diffuser can be clearly identified back to its corresponding luminaire.
- 1. Push bottom edge of the diffuser into backplate.
- 2. Slide diffuser out of backplate, keeping it inside its protective bag.
- · Carefully remove all diffusers.
- Set aside all diffusers to prevent from getting dirty or damaged.
- Ensure diffuser can be clearly identified back to its corresponding luminaire.

Kitted Hardware

- · Finelite has provided items listed here, with their Finelite part numbers. These items can be found in separate boxes shipped with the luminaire.
- Account for all parts and set aside until they are needed.
- All other hardware needed for this installation will be by others.






A. Release Backplates




- NOTE: If installing an independent, leave backplates installed and PROCEED TO STEP 4.
- Release backplate from luminaire body by removing the #8-18 x 1/4" screw from both ends of the luminaire.
- CAUTION: Set these screws aside. Do not lose.




- NOTE: If installing an independent, leave backplates installed and PROCEED TO STEP 4.
- Release backplate from luminaire body by removing the #8-18 x 1/4" screw and 1/4" washer from both ends of the luminaire.
- CAUTION: Set these screws and washers aside. Do not lose.

B. Remove Backplates








Step 4 - Mounting Starter to Structure

A. Make Electrical Connections





- · While properly supporting luminaire, maneuver luminaire near wall/ceiling opening.
- Make electrical connections at TOP of luminaire.

- · Remove screw holding conduit plate.
- Install flex conduit and nut onto conduit plate.
- · Wire-nut electrical connections. See wiring legend above.
- Reinstall conduit plate and screw. Do not damage any wires.





- Align mounting holes with hanging hardware.
- Install 1/4"-20 nut and 1/4" washer onto 1/4"-20 threaded rod.
- **CRITICAL:** If installing a joiner luminaire in the next step, leave nut loose.
- If there is no joiner/ender, then tighten nuts fully. **PROCEED TO STEP 7.**

Option 3 - Mount to Structure

- Place luminaire onto wall/ceiling and mount to structure support with hardware appropriate for the structure type.
- CRITICAL: If installing a joiner luminaire in the next step, leave loose.
- Support blocking² must not exceed distance to wall/ceiling surface¹.
- If there is no joiner/ender, then tighten nuts fully. **PROCEED TO STEP 7**.



² Support blocking = Wooden beams/studs, sheet metal framing beams, steel beams, concrete beams, etc. Use hardware appropriate to the blocking material



- · Align mounting holes with hanging hardware.
- Install 1/4"-20 nut and 1/4" washer onto 1/4"-20 threaded rod.
- NOTE: If installing a joiner luminaire, leave nut loose, allowing luminaire to hang at an angle.

Option 3 - Mount to Structure

- Mount to structure support with hardware appropriate for the
- NOTE: If installing a joiner luminaire, leave nut loose, allowing luminaire to hang at an angle.
- Align joiner/ender with aligner sleeves on starter and slide together. Be careful not to damage any wiring.
- If necessary, lift both luminaires, then slide them together.




Backplate 1/4" Washer (provided) #8-18 x 1/4" Screw (provided)

- 1. Carefully reinstall backplate into luminaire by inserting and rotating.
- 2. Install joint cover plate by inserting into backplate and installing two #8-18 x 1/4" screws at the joint. PROCEED TO STEP 7C.
- 1. Carefully reinstall backplate into luminaire by inserting and rotating.
- 2. Install 1/4" washer and #8-18 x 1/4" screw to backplate at both ends of the luminaire.

B. Secure Joint with #10 x 1/2" Screws HP-4 Only



• Install 1/4" washers and #10 x 1/2" screws at the joint.





C. Final Step - Replace Diffusers

- NOTE: If your installation includes a battery backup, please see addendum (98333) that should be included with your kitting package.
- · Remove diffusers from protective plastic bag.
- CAUTION: Wear gloves to keep diffuser surface clean.
- CRITICAL: Be sure to install correct diffuser to its corresponding luminaire ID.
- Install diffusers into luminaire body, ensuring they are in place.
- 1. Slide the side of the diffuser without a notch into the luminaire.
- 2. Push the side of the diffuser that has a notch until click sound is heard.
- Turn power on to luminaire.

- NOTE: If your installation includes a battery backup, please see addendum (98333) that should be included with your kitting package.
- · Remove diffusers from protective plastic bag.
- CAUTION: Wear gloves to keep diffuser surface clean.
- CRITICAL: Be sure to install correct diffuser to its corresponding luminaire ID.
- Install diffusers into luminaire body, ensuring they are in place.
- 1. Reinstall diffusers by pushing right side of the diffuser into the backplate.
- 2. Push the left side of diffuser until it lays flat on the backplate.
- Turn power on to luminaire.
