

- This installation requires **proper support** as each luminaire is being installed.







HPR 1'x1' Drywall Installation Instructions **Step 1** - Identification & Preparation



A. Identify Luminaire



- Identify all luminaires by their ID label that can be found on box and inside luminaire.
- **NOTE:** Exact location of labels in these areas may vary.
- · Remove luminaire from box.
- Refer to Record Drawings that can be found in hardware kit.

Kitted Hardware


- Finelite has provided items listed here, with their Finelite part numbers. These items can be found in separate boxes shipped with the luminaire.
- Account for all parts and set aside until they are needed.
- All other hardware needed for this installation will be by others.

B. Locate ID Label Bottom-Up View




- Remove door by pulling straight down and squeezing the retention springs.
- · Locate ID label inside luminaire.
- Bend butterfly brackets about 45 degrees on both sides.


HPR 1'x1' Drywall Installation Instructions **Step 2** - Mounting & Rough-In



A. Mounting Measurements Bottom-Up View




- Refer to Record Drawings and building plans to determine exact mounting and power feed
- Use proper backing. Drywall or weak paneling must be secured to support blocking (studs) around wall/ceiling.



Stud On-Center Spacing	Drywall Bracket
14"-17"	Erico™ Caddy TSGB16
17"-26"	Erico™ Caddy TSGB24

- · Measure stud on-center spacing and choose appropriate drywall brackets or equivalent.
- Insert drywall brackets through butterfly brackets.

C. Stud Clearance Side View




• Bend drywall brackets on both ends and align luminaire so that it's 1/2" below the studs.



Mount Luminaire to Structure Bottom-Up View



- Use appropriate fasteners to mount luminaire to structure.
- NOTE: 1-1/2" wood screws are recommended for wood joists.
- · Use four screws per drywall bracket.








A. Install Power Feed Top-Down View

B. Reinstall Conduit Plate Top-Down View



- Remove conduit plate from top of luminaire.
- · Connect all necessary wiring.
- Secure flex conduit to conduit plate.

• Reinstall conduit plate by tucking wires back into luminaire and fasten conduit plate back into place.









HPR 1'x1' Drywall Installation Instructions Step 5 - Closing Luminaire









- Cut 12-1/4" x 12-1/4" square hole in drywall.
- Install drywall, making sure cutout aligns with luminaire.
- If necessary, adjust by using the wing nuts on the side.
 NOTE: The bottom of the luminaire should be flush with the drywall after installation.

- Replace door by pressing retention springs to align with cutout on luminaire body.
- Press the door into place.
- NOTE: If there are light leaks or gaps, go back to Step 5A to adjust the housing.
- Turn power on to luminaire.
